Phil G: We need human resources for flyer days or cards. We could also do park benches. It would definitely be an investment but it could save some addicts before they reach jails, institutions or death.

Shane C: We could also look into the free clinics around town.

Brad H: this would be good to take back to the groups, maybe make a flyer for groups about forming a committee.

Phil G: lets definitely take this back to the groups and revisit with group response.

Brad H: This is the first year that Huggie bears will not be holding a gratitude dinner. We could do a speaker, dinner and raffle.
